




Canadian Glendyne Slate

Preferred by builders and architects for its exciting and aesthetic results, slate also offers true individuality.






SVK Artificial Slate

To add to that, it is a formidable form of recycling which is very important as it stops materials ending up as landfill. Reclaimed slate can often work out cheaper than new slate, and if they are of good quality they should last up to 100 years.

Reclaimed slate will have to be salvaged and saved from another roof. Whilst they are technically second hand they are usually of high quality and have an excellent life span if laid & installed correctly.






Copper Roofing

When copper is freshly installed it presents a natural bright finish but over the course of a few months this finish will mellow to a smooth deep bronze colour before finally developing a completely unique verdigris patina. Copper is one of those freakish materials on this planet that the older it gets the better it looks.

Z600 Galvanised Steel




